**OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff Nora Rasman's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order/Preliminary Injunction (the "Motion") [2]. Based on the Motion and the evidence presented during a hearing held today, March 29, 2018, the Court grants the Motion and orders as follows.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff Nora Rasman's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order / Preliminary Injunction [2] is **GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART**. Plaintiff and that group of people which she described in her testimony today and with whom she has engaged in activities

today at the Georgia State Capitol (the “Group”) may engage in the following activity at the capitol during the remainder of the ongoing legislative session:

1. The Group may, in the areas of the capitol defined below, display posters, written on standard size poster board not larger than approximately 22 inches x 28 inches on which they may express their opposition to S.B 452.

2. The areas in which the poster boards may be held for viewing by those passing by are (i) the rotunda area of the capitol and (ii) the balcony around the rotunda. The Group shall not have or display their posters in the chambers of either the Senate or House of Representatives.

3. The Group shall be silent while they hold their posters in the allowed places.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Capitol Police and any other law enforcement with knowledge of this Order shall not prohibit the Group from engaging in the activity described above.
